Parent & Carer Information

At Shyna Promise, the safety, wellbeing and enjoyment of every participant is at the heart of everything we do. We have carefully designed our School Holiday Program to provide exciting new experiences, build confidence and social connections, and support participants to engage with their community in a safe, inclusive and fully supported environment.

Transport & Pick Up Information

- Transport is available for participants and may be shared with other participants depending on location and travel requirements.
- Our designated pick up and drop off location is:

- Children are transported in staff vehicles that are fully registered, roadworthy and insured. All staff hold current driver's licences, maintain clean driving records and carry comprehensive motor vehicle insurance.
- Unless otherwise stated, participants should be dropped off at 9:00am and collected at 3:00pm.

Australia Zoo Day

- Due to travel requirements, participants attending Australia Zoo are required to arrive at 7:30am.
- A comfort stop will be completed during travel for stretching and toilet breaks.
- Although the day may exceed six hours due to travel time, support charges for Australia Zoo are capped at 6 hours of support. This outing operates on a 1:1 support ratio due to the environment, participant needs and assessed risk level.

Service Agreements & Funding

A School Holiday Service Agreement must be completed prior to attendance. This agreement outlines:

- Booked activity days
- Support hours
- Support costs
- Transport arrangements
- Cancellation requirements

Transport may be paid privately or claimed through eligible NDIS Core Supports, depending on individual circumstances and plan funding.

What to Bring

Participants should bring:

- A packed lunch
- Morning tea and snacks
- Water bottle
- Hat
- Sunscreen
- Weather-appropriate clothing
- Comfortable enclosed footwear

For fairness and consistency across the group, we will not be making drive-through food purchases or additional food stops throughout the day unless specifically stated within the activity description.

Outdoor activities require suitable sun-safe clothing and appropriate footwear.

Collection & Return Home

- Our activity days generally operate from 9:00am to 3:00pm.
- Participants will return to our home base by approximately 3:00pm for collection.
- Home drop-offs will commence from approximately 3:15pm onwards, once participants being collected from the home base have departed.

Safety & Support

- All activities have been designed to be inclusive and accessible for participants of varying ages, abilities and support needs.
- Our team will support participants to engage in each activity within their individual capacity while maintaining their physical safety, emotional wellbeing, dignity and independence.

All staff members:

- Hold current First Aid and CPR qualifications
- Hold valid NDIS Worker Screening Clearances
- Hold valid Working with Children (Blue Card) clearances
- Carry fully stocked first aid kits in their vehicles
- Carry fire extinguishers and fire blankets in their vehicles
- Have access to participant emergency information and support plans
- Follow medication reminders, procedures and digital check-in systems where required
- Comprehensive risk assessments have been completed for each activity, venue and transport arrangement, including emergency response and evacuation procedures.

Photography & Communication

- Photos are only taken with parent or guardian permission.
- No participant photographs will be used on social media, marketing material or our website without prior written consent.
- Parents and carers may request updates throughout the day and our team will happily provide check-ins where practical.
